**San Jose:** On Friday, January 16, 2009, at 9:14 AM, a San Jose Police officer attempted to arrest a subject who was seated in a parked stolen car. The officer spotted the suspect vehicle in the Gould Shopping Center and ran a routine license plate check through SJPD Communications, who then alerted the officer the car was confirmed stolen out of the state of Washington.

The suspect exited the vehicle and immediately attacked the officer. The suspect gained control of the officers handgun during the fight and shot several rounds at the officer. The officer was not struck by any of the bullets and the suspect attempted to flee in the stolen 2006 Ford Taurus. The suspect collided with a vehicle on Capitol Expressway and then drove into the USA Gas parking lot on the N/W corner of Capitol Expressway at McLaughlin Ave.

Another officer located the suspect inside the USA Gas Station and ordered him to drop his weapon. The officer fired his service weapon, possibly striking the suspect.

The suspect ran deeper into the store and Patrol officers set up a perimeter and began evacuating the nearby businesses and homes. Officers found a ballistic helmet, bullet proof vest and several high-capacity bullet magazines in the suspects trunk. The Departments MERGE (SWAT), METRO, VCET, TEU and K9 Units (Special Operations) were called to the scene to relieve the Patrol Officers.

Special Operations broke out several windows and used concussion grenades (Flash Bangs) in an attempt to get the suspect to start communications with the Departments Tactical Negotiation Team.

After six hours without a response, MERGE Officers entered the USA Gas foyer and located the suspect dead in a back bathroom from an apparent self-inflicted gun shot wound. The Officers handgun was also located inside the building.

*Click It or Ticket Campaign Aims For Safe Thanksgiving*

**San Jose, Calif.** - The San Jose Police Department, in an effort to help bring everyone home safe for the holidays, will be aggressively enforcing the state's seat belt and child safety seat laws during a *Click It or Ticket* mobilization, taking place November 17-30, 2008.

The campaign relies on heavy enforcement and public education as a means to help reduce deaths and injuries on California roadways. California currently has a seat belt use rate of 95.7%.

California has a primary seat belt law which requires that every passenger in the car, including the driver, is required to wear a seat belt at all times. If stopped and found to be in violation, law enforcement will issue citations without warning. Tickets for first seat belt violations range from \$80 to \$91 for adults and \$330 to \$401 for children under age 16, depending on the county.

"While we are very happy with actually surpassing 95% usage, that still means that more than a million people are in real danger in the event of a crash," said Christopher J. Murphy, Director of the Office of Traffic Safety (OTS). "It takes just two seconds to reduce your chances of dying in a crash by half."

Teens and nighttime car occupants lag behind others as far as buckling up is concerned. Officers will be concentrating even more on ensuring they are properly restrained. More than 280 law enforcement agencies statewide will be participating in this year's *Click It or Ticket* mobilization.

Funding for officer overtime to support California's *Click It or Ticket* campaign was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

In an ongoing effort to keep the San Jose community safe, the San Jose Police Department will be the first major city in Northern California to patrol the downtown area with the Segway personal transporters. Three Segways will be donated to the San Jose Police Department by the San Jose Police Foundation, the non-profit organization started in 2006 by community members and supported by Chief Robert L. Davis. Segways have been used successfully at the Mineta San Jose International Airport since 2005 and we were the first in California to use the transporters. The Segways will be primarily used by the Police Department's Downtown Services Detail (DSD) to help patrol the downtown area on weekend evenings.

The Segways, which cost about \$6,000 each, provide a great opportunity for the San Jose Police Department to be seen by the public as the officers are more visible during their patrols. The riding platform is 8 inches high at the base and allows citizens to approach the officers in the true spirit of community policing. The Segways patrolling Downtown will also provide a visible deterrent in an effort to curb criminal activities. The Segways can travel at a maximum speed of 12 mph. After a full charge, which will cost only 10 cents, the Segways have the ability to travel up to 24 miles. This will further support Mayor Reed's Green Vision Goal for San Jose.

The Foundation hopes to fund the purchase of 2-3 additional Segways next year after they host their marquee fundraiser, Bowling for Badges, which raised over \$50,000 during last years event. The next Bowling for Badges event will take place on May 14, 2009 and is open to businesses who wish to bowl and compete in an effort to further support the foundation's goals in keeping the citizens of San Jose safe.

Chief Robert L. Davis will be joined by the president of the Foundation, Leigh Weimers, and other Foundation board members to say a few words about the positive work of the Police Foundation and the goals to support public safety. Please join Chief Davis and Leigh Weimers to observe the Segways in action by the DSD officers.
