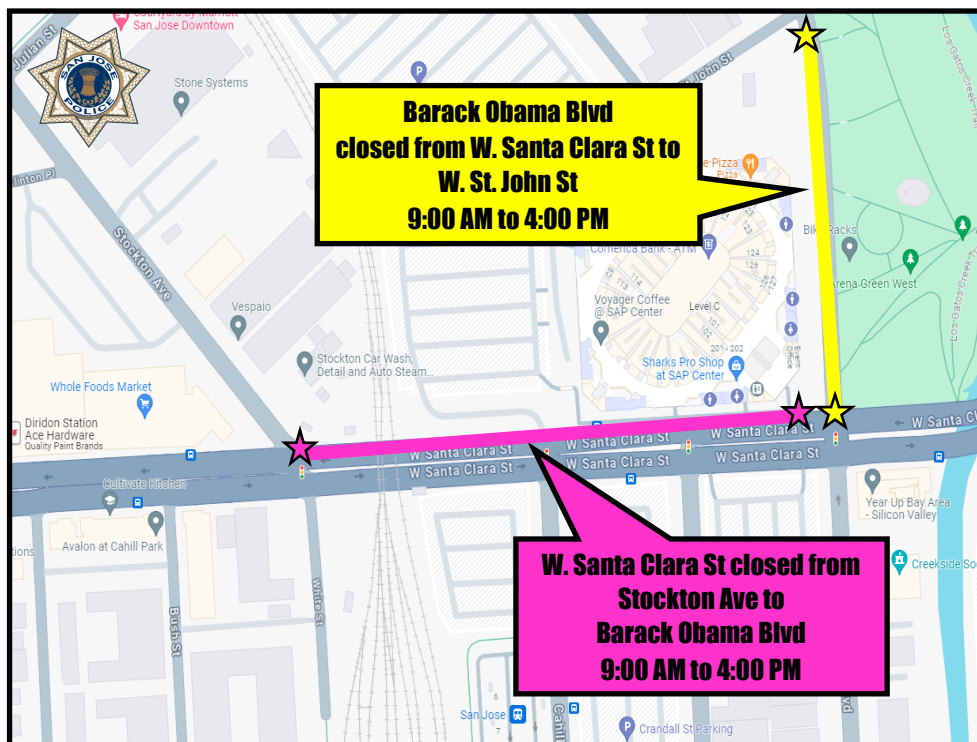

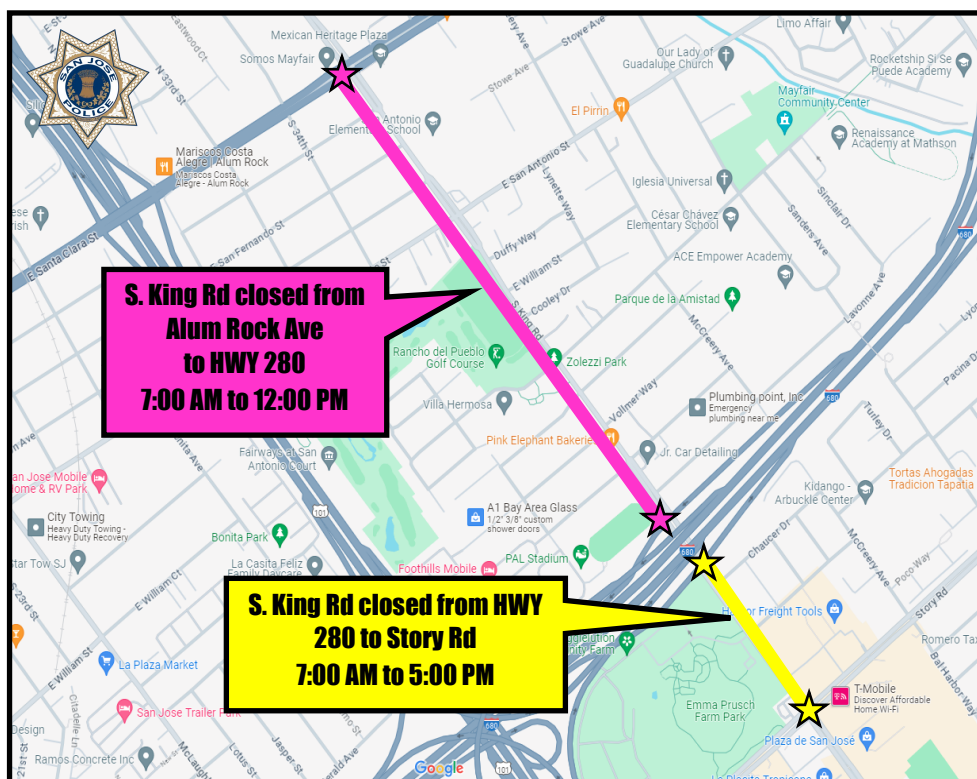
- 1.) #1 lane of S. Market Street surrounding perimeter of Plaza de Cesar Chavez from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM

- 3.) #1 lane of S. Market Street surrounding perimeter of Plaza de Cesar Chavez from 7:00 AM-10:00 PM

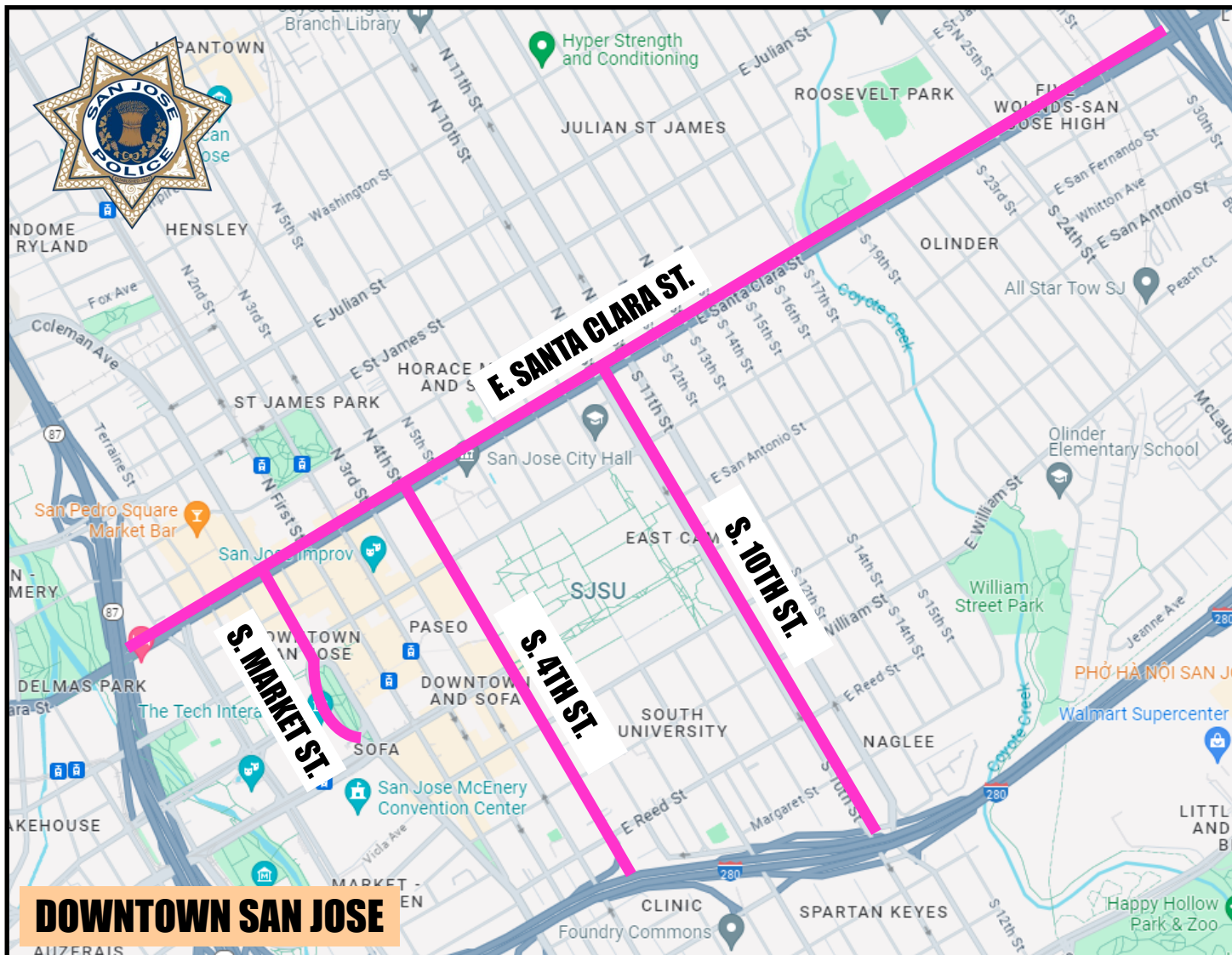

CLOSURES:

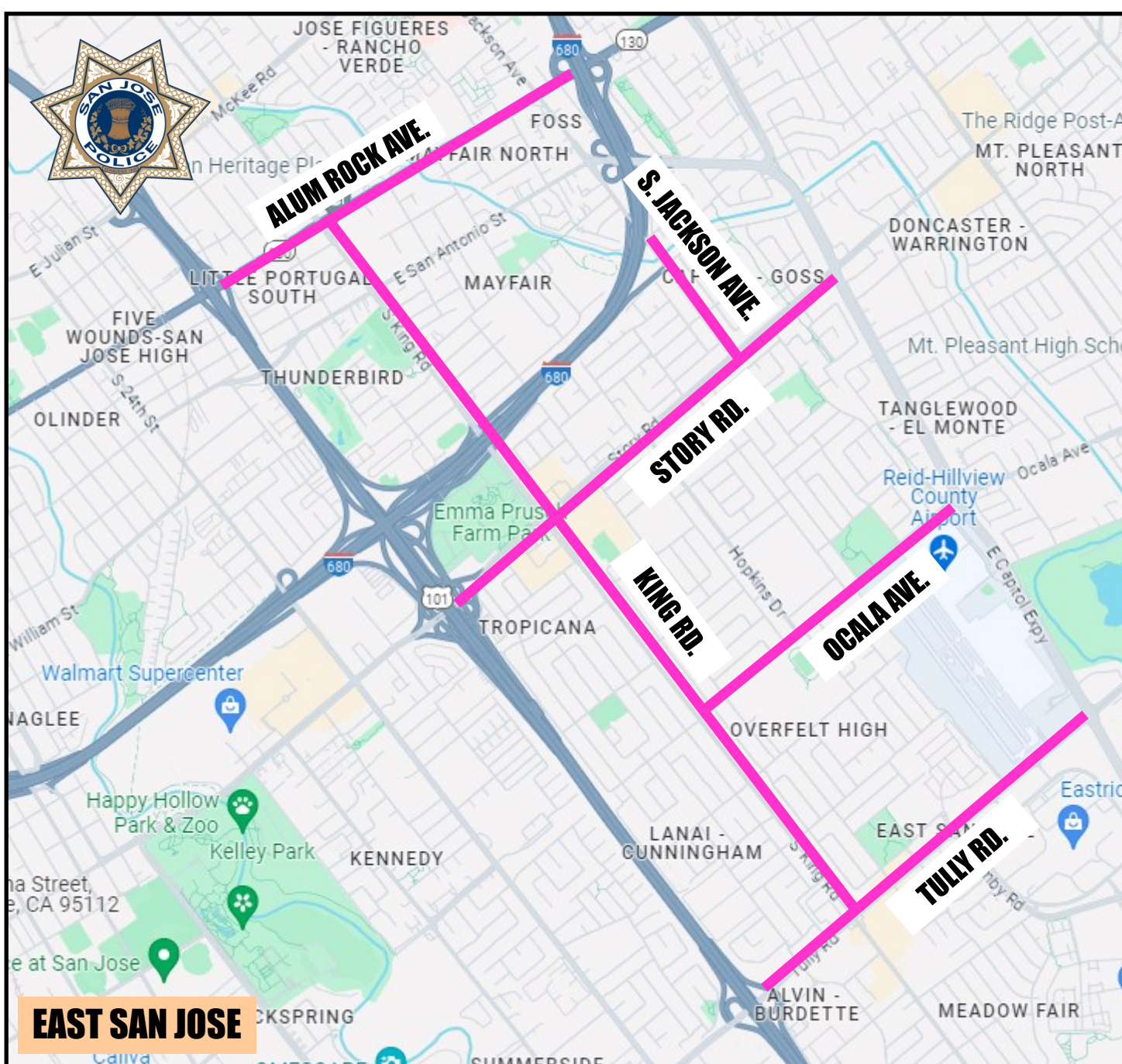
- 1.) S. King Road from Alum Rock Avenue to HWY 680 from 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM
- 2.) S. King Road from HWY 680 to Story Road from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- 3.) HWY 680 on and off ramps for S. King Road will be closed

POTENTIAL DIVERSIONS:

- 1.) E. Santa Clara Street from HWY 87 to HWY 101
- 2.) S. Market Street from E. Santa Clara Street to Plaza to Cesar Chavez
- 3.) S. 4th Street from E. Santa Clara Street to HWY 280
- 4.) S. 10th Street from E. Santa Clara Street to HWY 280
- 5.) Roosevelt Park will be fenced off



POTENTIAL DIVERSIONS:

- 1.) Alum Rock Avenue from HWY 101 to HWY 680
- 2.) King Road from Alum Rock Avenue to Tully Road
- 3.) Story Road from King Road to E. Capitol Expressway
- 4.) S. Jackson Avenue from HWY 680 to Story Road
- 5.) Ocala Avenue from King Road to E. Capitol Expressway
- 6.) Tully Road from HWY 101 to E. Capitol Expressway

DISCLAIMER:

- These potential traffic diversions are based on historical data of impacted areas and are subject to change based on congestion and day-of needs.
- If implemented, vehicles will be diverted to freeways or other surrounding streets to decongest roadways and address criminal activity.
- This may include temporary closures of freeway off-ramps.
